

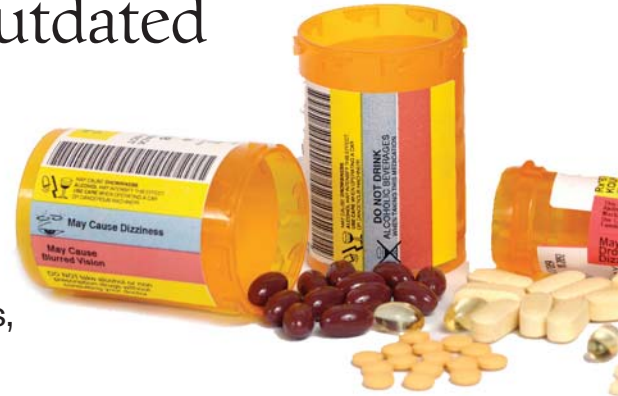


US Drug Enforcement Administration Medication Collection Day
